We, the undersigned officers of the Board of Directors (the "Board") of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 151 (the "District") hereby certify as follows:

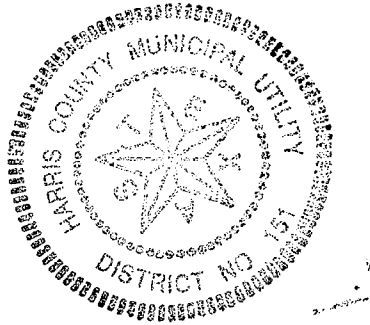

ORDER CALLING DIRECTORS ELECTION

WHEREAS, Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 151 (the “*District*”) is required to hold a Directors Election on the second Saturday in May unless each candidate in the election is unopposed; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (the “*Board*”) of the District deems it necessary and appropriate to establish the procedures whereby such election may be held;

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED BY THE BOARD THAT:

1. Pursuant to Section 49.103 of the Texas Water Code and Section 41.001 of the Election Code, an election shall be held for and within the District on May 8, 2010, for the election of three Directors for the District, each of whom shall serve a four-year term.

2. The Board finds that it is not practicable to hold the election in a public building within the District. Accordingly, such election shall be held at **20206 Hickory Wind, Humble, TX 77346**, within the District, and the entire District shall be and its boundaries are designated as one election precinct.

3. The Board appoints the following officers of such election:

Irene Blair	Presiding Judge
Don Blair	Alternate Presiding Judge
Irene Blair	Early Voting Clerk

The Presiding Judge shall appoint two clerks (one of whom shall be the Alternate Presiding Judge) to assist the Judge in the conduct of the election. If the Presiding Judge is unable to serve and the Alternate Presiding Judge conducts the election, the Alternate Presiding Judge shall appoint two clerks.

The Presiding Judge and the two clerks appointed by the Presiding Judge (or if the Alternate Presiding Judge conducts the election, the Alternate Presiding Judge and the two clerks appointed by the Alternate Presiding Judge) are hereby appointed as the early voting ballot board.

The officers of such election shall be compensated for services rendered at an hourly rate of **\$8.00**.

4. The Board finds that it is not practicable to hold the early voting in a public building within the District. Accordingly, early voting in such election by personal appearance shall be conducted at **20206 Hickory Wind, Humble, TX 77346**, being the main early voting polling place within the boundaries of the District. Early voting ballots for voting in

such election by mail may be obtained from and mailed to the Early Voting Clerk, 20206 Hickory Wind, Humble, TX 77346, which is the Early Voting Clerk's official mailing address. The Early Voting Clerk shall keep the office open for early voting by personal appearance from **7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.** and **1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.** on each day which is not a Saturday, Sunday or official State holiday, beginning on the 12th day (April 26th) and continuing through the fourth day (May 4th) preceding the date of such election.

5. The ballots for such election shall be prepared in sufficient number and in conformity with the Texas Election Code, as it may be amended from time to time, and shall be substantially as follows:

6. Such election shall be held and conducted in all respects as provided by applicable law. Notice of the election will be given by posting notice of the election on the bulletin board within the District used for posting notices of the meetings of the Board and in a public place in each election precinct in the District at least 21 days before the election. The Board adopts such form of notice as part of its election practices for this election and subsequent elections, until and unless such procedure is changed by formal action of the Board.

7. In the event the Secretary of the Board certifies that a candidate is unopposed for election to an office, the Board hereby determines that, pursuant to Sections 2.051 through 2.054 of the Election Code, it will declare such unopposed candidate elected to the

office without an election. The Board adopts the practice of canceling elections when permitted pursuant to Sections 2.052 through 2.053 of the Election Code as part of its election practices for this election and subsequent elections, until and unless such procedure is changed by formal action of the Board.

8. Voting will be conducted by paper ballot and an electronic voting system certified by the Texas Secretary of State as complying with the requirements for an accessible voting system established by the Help America Vote Act. Such voting system is described on Exhibit A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof. The Board hereby directs the Secretary or his or her agent to provide in each polling place a voting system, which has been certified by the Texas Secretary of State as complying with the requirement for an accessible voting system. The Secretary may obtain the voting system from any available legal means, including leasing it from Harris County, Texas. The Board hereby adopts the use of paper ballots and the accessible voting system described in Exhibit A as part of its election practices for this election and subsequent elections, until and unless such procedure is changed by formal action of the Board.

9. The Secretary of the Board hereby appoints and the Board approves the appointment of Carla Christensen of Fulbright & Jaworski L.L.P. as the Secretary's agent to perform the duties provided by Section 31.123 of the Election Code.

10. The officers of the Board are each authorized to evidence adoption of this Order and directed to do any and all things legal and necessary to hold such election and otherwise to carry out the intent hereof.

11. In case any provision in this Order shall be invalid, illegal or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired thereby.
